# GUITAR BOOGIE SHUFFLE

Traditional

Allegro

The sheet music for "Guitar Boogie Shuffle" is written for two guitars in 4/4 time, with a key signature of three sharps (F#, C#, G#). The tempo is marked "Allegro".
